

Course Description

- This course includes scope & sequence, lesson plans and resources (including videos, project supports, teacher’s scripts, student reading materials, teacher presentations, and more) to implement one 18-week session. Suggested Duration: 2 to 3 hours per week of student facing time
- Certification results from passing the Animation-ish exam.
- While developed for Middle Schools as a pathway to High School and College courses, this course can be levelled as appropriate for 4th-10th grade students.

❖ Certification in Animation-ish

This course is a foundation for a high school animation CTE program and provides preparatory background skills related to professional certification in the animation industry. Students will be introduced to the history of animation and will collaborate on animation productions simulating the roles of a professional animation studio. Course experiences will include the mastery of professional level software features and functions using student-friendly software that naturally scaffolds to more complex tools used by professional animators.

- Understand and be able to show the 12 principles of animation in their work.
- Demonstrate knowledge needed to identify and set project requirements.
